

Health and Safety Policy

McCosker Contracting Pty Ltd (McCosker) has a responsibility to provide a safe place of work. This responsibility extends to providing healthy working conditions for the prevention of work related injuries and illness across all of McCosker's sites, projects, assets and properties.

McCosker's responsibilities in relations to workplace health and safety shall be pursued with the same determination as any other management objectives.

Consequently, McCosker will ensure that all reasonable practical action is taken to:

- Involve employees in a consultative process to establish ways to reduce the workplace hazards and improve control systems.
- Promote the values of McCosker by ensuring a positive WHS culture through visible leadership and proactive strategies.
- Provide and maintain plant, equipment and systems of work that minimize risks to the health and safety of Company employees.
- Provide all necessary information, instruction, training, management and supervision.
- Provide personal protective equipment where required, instruction of its use and monitor for effectiveness and compliance.
- Protect members of the public and customers from potentially adverse health and safety effects associated with McCosker's operations.
- Establish measurable objectives and targets to ensure continued improvement of the system, thus eliminating work related injuries and illnesses.
- Ensure compliance with all relevant OHS legislation, whilst complying with the specific requirements of client owned and operated sites.
- Audit and review all systems to continuously improve our health and safety outcomes.

Employees are expected to:

- Follow reasonable, lawful instructions for the health and safety of themselves and others.
- Conduct activities and behave in a manner that does not adversely affect the health and safety of themselves and others.
- Comply with all McCosker policies and procedures.
- Conduct the required risk assessments prior to undertaking any activity.
- Encourage all others at the workplace.
- Maintain a level of housekeeping to ensure a safe and healthy work environment.
- Participate in training and ongoing instruction.
- Report all injuries, illness or incidents in a timely manner.
- Monitor, report and rectify any hazards or unsafe conditions, and
- Use protective equipment, tools and plant supplied as designed and instructed by McCosker.

Employees must not:

- Endanger their own health or safety or that of others at the workplace.
- Recklessly interfere with or misuse anything provided for health and safety or any other purpose.

McCosker will provide adequate resources to maintain the health and safety of all systems.
